## ALTERNATIVE APPROVAL PROCESS

The Board of Directors of the Thompson-Nicola Regional District intends to adopt Nicola Valley Mosquito Control Service Establishment Bylaw No 2526, 2015 that will establish a nuisance mosquito control function within Electoral Areas “M” and “N” at an annual cost not to exceed \$100,000 or \$0.137 per thousand of assessment for land and improvements.

A copy of Bylaw No. 2526 and elector response forms are available from the TNRD office during regular business hours (Monday to Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM except Statutory holidays). The bylaw and the elector response form are also available from the TNRD website at [www.tnrd.ca](http://www.tnrd.ca).

### ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

In order to sign an elector response form, a person must either be a resident of Electoral Area “M” or Electoral Area “N” OR be a non-resident property elector who owns property in Electoral Area “M” or “N” and lives elsewhere in BC. Qualifications are defined in the *Local Government Act*:

**Resident Electors** are individuals who are entitled to sign an elector response form during this AAP by virtue of living within either Electoral Area “M” or “N” and meeting the following qualifications.

1. Age 18 or older; and
2. A Canadian Citizen; and
3. A resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months; and
4. A resident of Electoral Area “M” or “N” for at least 30 days; and
5. Not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting.

**Non Resident Property Electors** are individuals who are entitled to sign an elector response form during this AAP by virtue of owning property within either Electoral Area “M” or “N” and meeting the following qualifications.

1. Not a resident elector; and
2. Age 18 or older; and
3. A Canadian Citizen; and
4. A resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months; and
5. A person who is the registered owner of real property in Electoral Area “M” or “N” for at least 30 days; and
6. Not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting; and
7. Not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust.

A person may only sign as a non-resident elector for one parcel within the area to which this Alternative Approval Process applies regardless of the number of parcels they have interest in.

Where there is more than one person registered as the owner of real property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, only one of those persons may sign this Elector Response Form with the written consent of the majority of the other owners.

Please note: Corporations or businesses are not entitled to sign elector response forms
