EVACUATION ORDER

Pursuant to Section 5.4 of TNRD Local Authority Emergency Program Bylaw No. 2017, an Evacuation Order has been issued by Chair John Ranta from the Thompson-Nicola Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) in Kamloops.

A rapidly moving flooding event currently located near the community of Cherry Creek in Electoral Area “J” (Copper Desert Country) is threatening a portion of the Cherry Creek community.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Thompson-Nicola Regional District has ordered everyone to evacuate the following properties:

- 1472, 1490 and 1501 Greenstone Rd;
- 5080 and 5096 Lazy Acres Rd;
- 5160 and 5168 Beaton Rd
- 5012, 5032, 5064 and 5108 Trans Canada Hwy

If you are in the described area, you must leave immediately and report to the Emergency Social Services (ESS) Reception Centre in Kamloops at the McArthur Island Sport Centre, Lounge on second floor. It is also suggested that evacuees turn off the power and propane to their residences.
