# Resiliency Centre Set Up in Kamloops for Flood Victims

**For Immediate Release (May 11, 2017):** The Thompson-Nicola Regional District is opening a Resiliency Centre in Kamloops. The centre will provide information about disaster financial programs and offer clean-up kits to flood-impacted residents of the Regional District.

The TNRD Resiliency Centre will be set up at the Coast Kamloops Hotel and Convention Centre beginning Friday, May 12, from 2 p.m. until 6 p.m. The Centre will then be open on Monday, Wednesday and the following Friday, with the same hours of operation.

Representatives from the TNRD and the Canadian Red Cross will be on hand to provide information and offer assistance.
