Service BC to Help Flood-Affected Residents with Financial Assistance

For Immediate Release (May 16, 2017): The Province's Disaster Financial Assistance (DFA) Program has made arrangements with Service BC offices across the province to offer help with the DFA application process to residents affected by flooding.

DFA is offering this service especially for people who are out of their homes; without computer, printer or fax access; or may not be able to travel to their regional or municipal office for help applying for DFA.

Service BC offices are located in Kamloops (250-455 Columbia St.), Merritt (2194 Coutlee Ave.), and Ashcroft (318 Railway Ave.).

Service BC will offer the following:

- Provide DFA applications forms for homeowners, tenants, small businesses, farms and charitable organizations.
- Provide copies of the DFA Guide.
- Fax or e-mail completed applications to the Emergency Management Office in Victoria.
