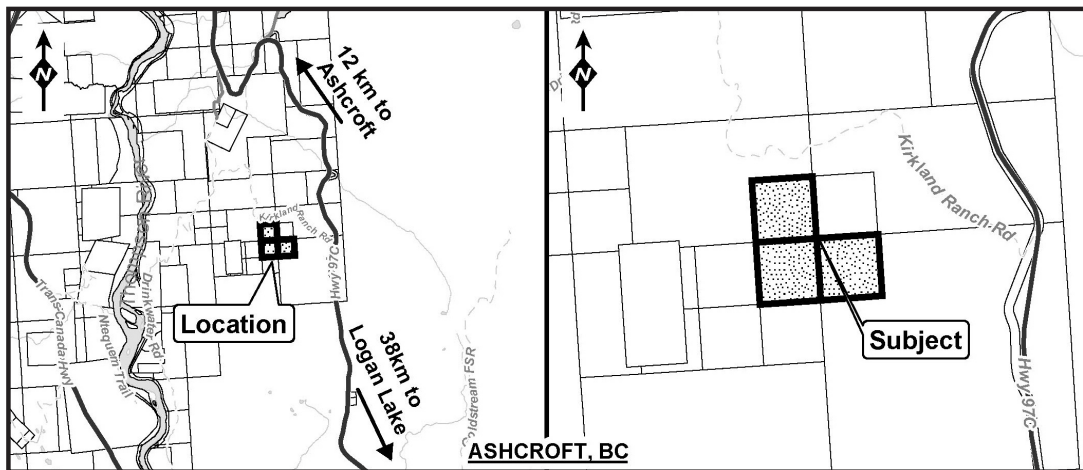

The Thompson-Nicola Regional District Board of Directors gives notice that it will hold a Public Hearing in the TNRD Boardroom, 4th Floor - 465 Victoria Street, Kamloops, BC, to consider proposed Bylaw No. 2697.

What is Zoning Amendment Bylaw 2697, 2019?

It amends Zoning Bylaw 2400 via a site-specific amendment to allow institutional uses, specifically the use of an existing lodge and 10 sleeping units on an adjacent parcel, for an education, treatment, and support facility for first responders and military personnel suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). The proposed site-specific terms acknowledge that *agriculture* remains the primary land use but the aforementioned ancillary uses would be allowed within the *RL-1: Rural* zone. Bylaw 2697 reads as follows:

- 8.1.1 Permitted Uses – Site Specific
 - (m) *institutional uses* in the case of Block A, Section 28, Township 19, Range 24, W6M, KDYD; Legal Subdivision 16, Section 21, Township 19, Range 24, W6M, KDYD; and Block A, Section 22, Township 19, Range 24, W6M, KDYD (south of Ashcroft, BC)



All persons who believe that their interest in property may be affected by the proposed Bylaw shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard at the Public Hearing. Additionally, they may make written submissions on the matter of Bylaw 2697 (via the options below) which must be received at our office prior to 9 a.m. on the 10th day of December, 2019. The entire content of all submissions will be made public and form a part of the public record.
