Renovations to Close Kamloops Library

For Immediate Release (February 23/18): The TNRD Library System will be temporarily closing Kamloops Library for renovations on Monday, February 26.

The last day of service to the public will be Sunday, February 25. Renovations are expected to take about six weeks.

While the Kamloops Library is closed, patrons are encouraged to keep their library materials at home. Extended loan periods will be provided.

Patrons are also encouraged to use the North Kamloops Library during the temporary closure. The branch will now be open Sundays (noon to 4 p.m.) in addition to its normal hours of operation.

This second temporary closure of the Kamloops Library will allow for the lion's share of the general construction (electrical, millwork, flooring, drywall, plumbing and painting) to be completed.

This will result in a more modern library that will create a functional space plan and patron self-service; interior "zoning" for noise-related activities; and visual identity.
