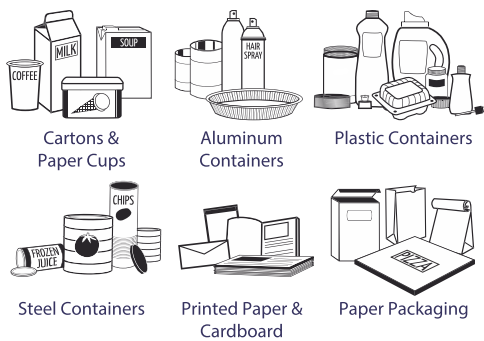

All garbage must be bagged.
All garbage must be contained within bin with the lid closed.

- No construction waste
- No hazardous waste
- No yard waste
- No liquid waste
- No motor oil

Have something that can't go in recycling or garbage cart?

The Blue River Eco-Depot accepts most recycling and waste types that cannot be collected curbside.

FAQs

What time is Collection?

On collection day, please put out your bins no later than 8am and no earlier than 6am. Garbage and recycling are collected separately. Garbage is collected first thing in the morning and recycling is collected in the late morning or early afternoon.

What about Snow Storms?

Please be patient as collection takes longer during the winter months. It is likely your garbage and recycling will be collected later in the day during snowy weather. When weather is extremely bad, collection may be completely cancelled. Collection will resume on the next regular scheduled collection day.

What if collection is cancelled or changed?

Please get added to the contact list by calling 1.877.377.8673 or email recycleright@tnrd.ca which will be used to notify residents if collection is delayed or cancelled due to any mechanical issues or unforeseen circumstances. Notifications will also be posted on the TNRD Facebook page and the local post office message boards.

What about Holidays?

Regular collection will occur on all stat holidays except Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day. When a collection day falls on Christmas Day, Boxing Day or New Year's Day, collection will be cancelled and will resume the following regular scheduled collection day.

What about Bears?

Remember to use the securing clips on the garbage containers when bears are active. Recycling bins are not bear resistant. Recyclables should be clean and free of all food residue. Garbage bins are bear resistant, but not bear proof. Garbage should be stored in a secure location except on collection day to minimize attractants.
