Solid Waste Flood Debris Fee Waiver Application - RESIDENTIAL

Flood Debris definition includes materials, matter, and objects that, after the water has risen, are unfit for use, in an unstable state, and likely to have negative effect on the environment and/or human health.

NOTE: Flood Debris does **NOT** include the demolition of full structures. See TNRD Landfill Waste Disposal Declaration for Full Structures and Potential Asbestos Containing Material Declaration.

*Only **Flood Debris** from flood-damaged property is eligible for fee waiver for the hauler/customer. All loads must have a completed declaration form at time of disposal. Full structure demolitions are not eligible for fee waiver.
