TNRL Announces Spring 2022 Program Offerings

Kamloops, BC – April 5, 2022 – The Thompson-Nicola Regional Library (TNRL) is excited to share its spring program schedule from April to June, featuring a range of events for all ages.

Story Dog is returning to our Kamloops Libraries, for children who need a little extra tender, love and care with their reading. Children read aloud to a St. John's Ambulance Therapy Dog for 15 minutes. These one-on-one sessions will take place on Saturdays at 10:30 a.m., from April 9 to June 11.

The TNRL has partnered with FireSmart BC to offer a variety of children activities through the spring to enhance wildfire preparedness and resiliency.

In-person *Technology Help* appointments are back at the Kamloops Libraries, where library users can receive personalized support with beginner technology questions. Virtual and phone appointments are also available.

Registration for all programs is now open. Regularly occurring programs will continue, including Storytime & Craft, Dungeons & Dragons for Teens, Book Clubs, and a host of special events.
