The following invasive plant species are eligible for treatment under the TNRD's New Invader Program. These species are regional early detection and rapid response species. They are extremely high priority for management within the TNRD.

The TNRD will cover UP TO 100% of the cost of invasive plant control, on listed new invaders, by a licensed contractor using herbicide. The cost covered by the TNRD may vary dependent upon the size and extent of the infestation and funding availability. The maximum amount the TNRD will cover is \$4,000. Exceptions to the maximum coverage may be considered under exceptional circumstances.

If the plant of concern is not on this list, please check to see if it is eligible for treatment under one of the following programs:
