



THOMPSON-NICOLA REGIONAL DISTRICT 2022 GENERAL ELECTION VOTING MAIL BALLOT VOTING INFORMATION

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A MAIL BALLOT?

To receive a mailing ballot a person must be eligible to vote as either a Resident Elector or a Non-Resident Property Elector (there is no corporate vote).

RESIDENT ELECTORS must:

- be 18 years of age or older on voting day; and
- be a Canadian citizen; and
- be a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day; and
- be a resident of the Electoral Area preceding voting day, and
- not otherwise be disqualified by law from voting.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS must:

- not be eligible to vote as a resident elector; and
- be 18 years of age or older on voting day; and
- be a Canadian citizen; and
- be a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day; and
- be a registered owner of real property in the Electoral Area for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day, and
- not otherwise be disqualified by law from voting.

Non-resident property electors must provide proof of ownership and if more than one person owns the property, written consent from the majority of other property owners is required. Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Forms are available for download at: www.tnrd.ca/elections-2022/

* Following receipt of the mail ballot, you are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received in the Regional District office no later than 8 PM local time on Saturday, October 15, 2022.
