UTILITY BILLING INFORMATION:

TNRD Utility customers can now pay their bill by online banking through most financial institutions. (Please select **Thompson-Nicola Regional District Utilities** as the payee). Customers can also pay by cheque, mailed to the TNRD Civic Building, or in-person at the TNRD Civic Building by Debit, cash or cheque.

To receive an email copy of your bill, contact finance@tnrd.ca. Please provide your 13-digit Utility account number, owner name(s) and email addresses.

IMPORTANT:

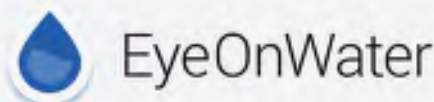
Quarterly billing is now required to go to the landowner of the property. This means that tenants will no longer receive these bills in their mail. (Per Bylaw 2757).

TO CALCULATE YOUR UTILITY BILL:

- Look at your Service code on your mock bill - that refers to the meter line size installed into your house.
- Look at the current read 1883 m³ (June 30th read) and your Previous read 1539 m³ (March 31)
- Total water Consumption for the March 31 to June 30 quarter is 1883 - 1539 = 344m³
- The base rate for a 19mm water services is \$150.00
- If the customer uses 0- 285 m³ of water, each m³ is \$0.47. Over 285 m³ is \$0.47/m³

Example of Calculation (Please refer your mock bill for your personal consumption information)

Base rate \$150.00
344m³ * \$0.47 = \$161.68
Total Mock Billing \$311.68

FALL 2022

Repairs have been completed on the corner of Station and Bridgeway Street in Spences Bridge. The TNRD water metering installation project is officially complete on all 11 Community Water Systems, with one outstanding property in Spences Bridge

having a meter installed earlier this year. Mock Billing has now commenced for users of the Spences Bridge Water System, with updated meter rates coming into effect to reflect fairer billing based on usage. This will also encourage conservation of water, saving

money and wear and tear over the course of a full year. Water metering also leads to faster leak detection on Community Water Systems. All residents are encouraged to sign up for EyeOnWater to monitor their water usage.
